For the second season in a row, the Saints will host the Class "B" State Tournament entrant in an early season matchup. Last season, the Bucs were able to top the home team by a score of 6-2, lead by cleanup hitting catcher, Lucas Nelson, who was 3-4 on the day. Taylor Nelson also added a home run for the Bucs.

Although the Saints offense was kept in check, Steve Boger was able to tally a pair of singles, reaching base in 4 of his 5 total plate appearances. Paul Jacobson, Jordan Flick, Ben Lindquist, Noah Halonen, and Paul Vetsch each added knocks as well.

Flick took the loss on the mound, although pitching decent, giving up two earned runs over 6 innings of work before handing it off to the bullpen.

Expect a variety of pitchers and hitters to see action on Opening Day, as the Saints attempt to get revenge on the Bucs to open the 2022 season.

## 2021 leaders

A LOOK AT THE PLAYERS THAT LEAD THE WAY LAST SEASON

With nearly the entire roster returning, it'll be interesting to see which of last season's top performers can help lead the charge, as well as which young Saints make their way on to the leaderboard.

Offensively, three Saints lead in most categories. Jim Althoff had the highest regular season batting average, posting a healthy .347 to go along with an OBP of .439. Althoff also lead the team in stolen bases with 14.

Tyler Brandel was able to flex, leading the team in several "power" categories. He lead the team with 4 home runs, as well as 11 doubles. 10 of those doubles came in league play, which put him at the #1 spot in the North Star League for that category. He also drove in a team leading 26 RBI and culminated a .486 slugging clip.

The Saints best all-around hitter in 2021 was Steve Boger, leading the team in OBP, OPS, hits, runs, and walks. Looking forward to this juggernaut's 2022 campaign.

On the hill, veteran Jordan Flick topped the team in most pitching categories, but Noah Halonen had the highest K/9, and James Howell had the most relief appearances.
